The ACE Competition team of Central lowa has been selected to compete nationally on May 14th in Washington D.C. for their project titled "Unboxed". Unboxed was selected as one of the three presentations out of 64 entries submitted nationally and was created by eight high school students challenged to create a playground or playscape for all ages that revitalized a neglected part of an urban area or city into an interactive landscape that encourages public engagement and community involvement along with keeping sustainable ideas in mind.

This event is open to the public and attendees are encouraged to not only listen about the project, but to interact and challenge the students with questions in preparation for the national competition.


